Eligibility requirements

Training partners must be able to satisfy the following requirements:

- ABN
- Public liability insurance
- Resume
- Certificate IV in Training and Assessment
- Current qualifications related to the courses you wish to deliver
- Evidence of current industry skills and experience
- Work referees to verify experience
- Video evidence of your training delivery
- Capacity to deliver training to a minimum of 60 people per year
- Sign a service agreement
- Complete training partner induction program



Key responsibilities

A training partner has the following responsibilities:

- Marketing and promoting training services to your potential clients/students
- Charging fees to clients as per Triple O Solutions Fee Schedule
- Booking courses using the calendar booking system
- Arranging equipment and materials for training courses
- Delivering training and assessment according to agreed procedures
- Sending scanned copies of training and assessment documentation to Triple O Solutions for processing
- Undertaking professional development and maintaining industry currency
